Payment Options:

All applications from BC residents require a non-refundable \$200 application fee per family (cash or cheque). All applications from applicants not residing in Canada at time of application require a \$400 application fee per family (non-refundable).

Parents of International Students in Grades 7-12 need to pay the full international student fee as soon as they are accepted, provide proof of legal guardianship if student is not staying with at least one parent, and proof of medical insurance before a formal acceptance letter will be issued.

ADDITIONAL FEES AND SCHOOL UNIFORM INFORMATION

Our Elementary Campus does not require students to wear uniforms. However, all elementary students are expected to dress appropriately and modestly. Any logos on clothing should be in good taste. Spaghetti straps, tube tops, and bare midriff shirts are not allowed. Shorts and shirts should be of proper length. Students should also refrain from having permanent tattoos and any form of body piercing (except pierced ears). Caps are to be removed upon entering the building. Student clothing and demeanor should reflect a wholesome Christian attitude.

• The Elementary Campus requires students beginning in Grade 4 to purchase (from the front office) a PE shirt. Students supply their own black shorts.

The Secondary Campus is a uniform school. The purpose of the school uniform and gym strip is to assist in creating a positive learning environment that is free of distractions and disruptions and to encourage students to represent the school in a positive light while fostering a sense of community.

- Students at the Secondary Campus will need to pay a fee for extracurricular sports, which will vary from year to year, sport to sport and tournament to tournament as well as based on how many a student participates in. That fee will be communicated through students via the PE/sports office.
